SHOW RULES

- 1. Close of entries is <u>one week prior to each show</u>. No entries will be accepted without enclosed payment.
- 2. Refunds will be made only with written certificate from a Veterinarian/Doctor.
- 3. Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25 processing fee above the balance owed.
- 4. The show will be held in accordance with the rules and procedures set forth by USA Equestrian Federation Rules.
- 5. Appropriate attire is required. Juniors must wear approved helmets while riding. All participants under the age of 18 must wear protective headgear. All exhibitors are required to wear shoes or boots with a riding heel whenever on horseback on the show grounds.
- 6. Awards will be given for the highest % achieved. Ribbons will be awarded 1st-5th place.
- 7. All dogs must be restrained at all times while at the show grounds.
- 8. All horses must remain in designated areas on the show grounds. There is no lounging/riding outside of designated areas. Please observe all posted rules.
- 9. All riders must sign a release form.
- 10. Do not litter and please clean up after your horse.
- 11. Keep small children supervised.

Directions to Bercut Equitation Field

From the North take 101 South over the Golden Gate Bridge. Take the 19th Ave exit. Stay on 19th Ave (which becomes Park Presidio) until you are through Golden Gate Park. Immediately turn right onto Lincoln Way, then right on 41st Ave. Go through the stop sign, see Bercut Field on your left.

From the South take 280 North, and left exit onto 19th Ave. Turn right onto Irving St., then left onto 18th Ave, left again onto Lincoln Way, right at 41st Ave. Go through stop sign, see Bercut Field on your left.
